

MIRROR LAKE US – 1464 KKF – 1464


- Opened in 1966





There was rain, freezing rain and light snow. It did move out just as quick as it moved in, however we were packed up and already heading out.




CRAZY HORSE MEMORIAL SOUTH DAKOTA

Think of the Ford Test Track, much larger of course, with a man-made lake with a beach in the middle and walking path and picnic shelters surrounding it








Thankfully from Iowa home, it was sunny!








